Senior Portrait Information

We look forward to including you/your senior in the 2024 Magenta yearbook! We are offering three options for senior portrait submissions this year:

- You can submit a photo from your own photographer.
- You can have us use the Lifetouch photo taken at the beginning of the school year as long as it's a formal portrait.
- You can have the yearbook staff take one. If you choose to have the yearbook staff take a photo, we will take one formal head and shoulder shot for use in the yearbook. Time and location for these photos will be determined later by the yearbook staff and communicated with your student.

If you are submitting a photo from your own photographer, please share the following specs with your photographer before or during your senior portrait session:

-Technical Requirements-

- **High quality digital photos** must be submitted as 300 DPI -- JPEG format
- Each photo file should be saved as: "**last name, first name.jpeg**". For example, "Smith, Mary.jpeg". (Please do not label using a number— this is very confusing!)
- Photo size: at least **2"x3"**

-Aesthetic Requirements-

- **Color** photos only (no black/white).
- **Vertical photos only** we cannot use horizontal shots on our senior portrait pages
- **No studio or student/photographer name** on front of photo.
- **Crisp focus**; no blurred photos.
- **Traditional portrait format** (head and shoulder poses). We prefer to have a close-up of the student from the chest up, rather than a portrait that is further away and shows additional scenery.

The following are **NOT** permitted in any senior portrait submitted for the yearbook:

- Hats, sunglasses, or full-body poses
- Tube tops or anything revealing
- Shirts with sayings or emblems
- Firearms
- Selfies
- Jewelry that is not considered jewelry (i.e. chains, etc)
- Hands on faces, in the air, or making inappropriate gestures
- Obscured faces
- Props, friends, family, or pets

If in doubt, please err on the side of caution and do not include it.

*We will **NOT** be accepting any private digital photographs on CD, flash drives or by email.*

One Final Note...

I thank you for your beautiful work on behalf of our students and your continued support of our seniors and our publishing programs. Your help in guaranteeing that all seniors are represented with a professional quality photo, while ensuring our publishing standards are met, will help us to best showcase your work and produce the quality books our entire community looks forward to sharing.

Your senior portrait needs to be a head and shoulder shot that is in color and vertical (not horizontal). Portraits are due, uploaded to ReplayIt (<https://images.jostens.com/ImageShare/upload>) by Thursday, October 12, 2023. If you are asked for an ID, please use this code: **01DS_4r1ywKBHVlQKWYfW8w**
